Camp Aloma is a small Lutheran Camp supported by our church located in the pines west of Prescott about three miles past Thumb Butte Park. We have reserved the whole camp for our church's family camping weekend.

## Included

Saturday breakfast, lunch, dinner and Sunday breakfast are cooked and served in the dining hall by the camp directors Bob and Shirley Urie. Snacks will be provided Friday night. Families can eat in Prescott on the way up on Friday. Check in anytime on Friday after 3pm. The camp has facilities for indoor sleeping with bunks, flush toilets and showers, and outdoor tent areas.

Activities include crafts, hikes, basketball, Frisbee golf, relay games, ball games, water balloons, singing and worship, a great time to relax and have fun with your family. There is a playground for small children, swings and plenty of room to run around. There is no swimming or pool.
